

June 8-11, June 15-18

At Whiz Kids Summer Camp, we will build on letter-sound knowledge and practice fine-motor activities, fine-tune skills through engaging indoor and outdoor activities and games, music, and our beloved Whiz Kids puppets and puppet theatre. Whiz Kids Summer Camp will provide a fun and active way for children to build on and solidify their foundation in literacy and keep them excited about learning! Designed for 4 and 5 year olds. Snacks provided. Maximum 5 campers per session.

Kindergarten Boot Camp

August 3-6, August 10-13, August 17-20

Kindergarten Boot Camp will include the main elements of our Kindergarten Readiness classes and will be structured like a condensed, mini-kindergarten day. In the tradition of Whiz Kids, we will keep things fun and active at every turn and incorporate the curriculum into kinesthetic indoor and outdoor activities and games while building on and reinforcing the skills needed for kindergarten. Using hands-on materials and engaging activities, we will focus on all emergent literacy and math skills, including number sense, letter sounds, sound blending, printing, and fine motor practice. Each day, campers will check out books at their own instructional level from the Whiz Kids library. Snacks provided. Maximum 8 campers per session.

Whiz Kids Summer Class Descriptions



Zoo-phonics Summer Workshop

(students must turn 4 by December 2, 2020)

Our Zoo-phonics Workshop has been our signature class since the inception of Whiz Kids in 2001. The Zoo-phonics Summer Workshop is a precursor to the Zoo-phonics Workshop that begins in the fall, which is designed for students to experience the year before entering a traditional Kindergarten program. Students get to know the 26 Zoo-phonics animals and work closely with them to gain mastery of the letter sounds and begin to blend these sounds into words. Children are gently guided in developing their fine motor and printing skills in a stress-free environment. Our small class sizes ensure that instruction is individualized to meet the needs of every student. The beloved Whiz Kids puppets are incorporated into the curriculum, as well as many other fun and motivational lessons that reinforce the letter sounds, book and print knowledge, and sound blending. Zoo-phonics Workshops provide a fun and active way for children to solidify their foundation in phonics, strengthen literacy skills, and get excited about reading!

Junior Kindergarten Readiness

Our Junior Kindergarten Readiness class is designed for 5 year olds who will be entering a pre-K or Junior Kindergarten program in the fall. These students may have already completed a year of Zoo-phonics and/or have some letter and sound knowledge. In this class, we build on letter-sound knowledge before moving on to blending sounds into words as the students individually become ready for this next step in the reading process. In the Junior Kindergarten Readiness class, we review all letters and sounds in every class meeting, and practice printing and fine-motor activities without stress. The kids fine-tune their skills through various engaging activities and games, music, and our beloved Whiz Kids puppets and puppet theatre. The Junior Kindergarten Readiness class is the perfect bridge between the Zoo-phonics Summer Workshop and Kindergarten Readiness.

Kindergarten Readiness

Designed for students entering kindergarten in the fall, our Kindergarten Readiness classes focus on building and reinforcing the skills needed for the kindergarten curriculum. Using hands-on materials and kinesthetic activities, we focus on all emergent literacy skills, including reviewing the letter sounds, blending sounds to read words, developing fine motor skills, printing letters and words, and writing sentences and stories. Prior completion of a Zoo-phonics class is not a prerequisite for enrollment in Kindergarten Readiness. Our goal is to find fun and active ways for children to reach the next step in their journey toward literacy and learn to love reading and writing. Each week, students in our Kindergarten Readiness classes check out books at their own instructional level from the Whiz Kids library. Our small class sizes ensure that the individual needs of each child are met at precisely their level.

First, Second, Third Grade Readiness

Designed for students entering first, second, or third grade in the fall, this class strikes a fine balance between specific instruction and motivating, literature-based activities that inspire a love of reading and prepare students for the first grade curriculum. Our goal is to build on literacy and learning while convincing the students how much fun it is to read and write. We focus on all emergent reading and writing skills, including printing and other fine motor activities. Each week, children check out books at their own reading level from the Whiz Kids library, and the students will each write and publish their own autobiographies and share in the Author's Chair. Our small class sizes enable students to hold regular conferences with their teacher to review their work and set new learning goals. As always, instruction is personalized to meet each student's unique learning needs.
